2. Identify the *sound device* that is used in the poem. Write the section that contains this sound device.
3. Identify a form of *figurative language* that is used in the poem. Write the section that contains this type of *figurative language*.

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Read the following poem. Once you are finished, answer the three questions beneath the poem.

<p><i>Ocean water waves Roll back and forth like a mom Rocks her child to sleep.</i></p>
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1. What is the meter in each line of this poem?

1<sup>st</sup> line – 5 syllables (2.5 feet)

2<sup>nd</sup> line – 7 syllables (3.5 feet)

3<sup>rd</sup> line – 5 syllables (2.5 feet)

2. Identify the *sound device* that is used in the poem. Write the section that contains this sound device.

*Alliteration – “...water waves”*

3. Identify a form of *figurative language* that is used in the poem. Write the section that contains this type of *figurative language*.

*Simile – “Roll back and forth like a mom rocks her child to sleep.”*
