Poetry Analysis Forms (2 copies per student)

Please use these forms to analyze the poetry we will be reading together in class. As you read, please do the following:

- 1. Find the meter of the poem by drawing a line between each syllable in the poem. These poems may have different line lengths in each line, so keep track of the length of every line in your poems.
- 2. Rhyme Scheme: For each group of rhyming words, letter them off. Write "A" for the first group of rhyming words, "B" for the second group, and so on.
- 3. Stanzas: Count the number of groups of lines in your poems.
- 4. Use your highlighters to identify the figurative language and sound devices. Use the following colors:
 - a. Similes in yellow.
 - b. Metaphors in green.
 - c. Personification in blue.
 - d. Alliteration in pink.
 - e. Assonance in red or orange.
